

Parent Information for Maths-Whizz



Dear Parent/Caregiver

iLearn Education is partnering with your school to provide Maths-Whizz, an incredibly powerful online personalised maths programme for your child.

Once your child has done their initial assessment, they have their own personalised adaptive programme aimed at filling in their gaps and giving them lessons targeting their learning needs.

Weekly Tutoring Journey – New Learning – Usage Cap - Do not help students!

There is usually a usage cap of 90 minutes of New Learning as without consolidation in Topic Challenge the programme can get too hard for them and they can become disengaged. Students receive lessons at their level, teaching them strategies and testing their understanding – it is important that parents do not help them at all in this area.

- Exercises – they get taught strategies and get help in the fun animated environment – 70% is needed to pass.
- Tests – animations and help is stripped away to allow students to learn to take what they have learnt in the animated lessons and apply it to questions that replicate their school based assessments – do not help in this area!
- A child will be able to jump ahead to the test if they are showing they can do it.
- A child will be automatically taken back if they are showing that the exercise is too hard.

- Students should aim to make 4 Learning Progressions a week in this area.



Topic Challenge –Consolidating their Learning – Unlimited Time

- If a student beats their last score/time they will earn 10 maths credits.
- If a student improves their score, they can work towards the Gold Medal.
- A student can add buddies and if they are working on similar activities, they challenge their buddies – they are not able to communicate with their buddies. Understanding Topic Challenge to Consolidate their Learning will help once students are gaining their 4 Learning Progressions in their Weekly Tutoring Journey.



Return on Investment – target of 4 Learning Progressions
